

## State of Missouri Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, the citizens of the state of Missouri stand firmly committed to increasing access to high-quality afterschool programs and opportunities because they provide safe learning experiences that help children become engaged, productive citizens; support their academic growth; increase school day attendance; increase positive social connections, protecting youth from substance use and social media harms; support working families by ensuring their children are safe while they remain productive at work; develop a strong workforce by preparing youth with STEM skills and teaching teamwork, communication, goal setting and creative problem solving; and provide a robust return on investment. For every \$1 invested in afterschool programs, \$3 are saved by increasing youth-earning potential; improving school performance; and reducing crime and juvenile delinquency; and

WHEREAS, the state of Missouri is committed to the education and well-being of our youth, and recognizes that quality afterschool programs prepare our children to become successful adults, helping our communities thrive; and

WHEREAS, Lights On Afterschool, the national celebration of afterschool programs held this year on October 24, 2024, promotes access to quality afterschool programs for our children, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS, the demand for afterschool programs continues to grow. For every child in a program, three are waiting to get in; yet, many afterschool programs face operating challenges so severe that they are forced to consider closing their doors and turning off their lights; and

WHEREAS, the state of Missouri is committed to providing expanded learning opportunities that help our children learn, grow, and develop the skills essential for success in life and work.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael L. Parson, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, do hereby proclaim October 24, 2024, to be
